Parade Honors War Hero

General Odysseus T. Grant, who led the American Expeditionary Force in France during the Great War, returned to Washington, DC to a ticker-tape parade in his honor.

The General's forces distinguished themselves during heavy fighting, and Grant himself was recently made General of the Armies of the United States, a rank he shares only with George Washington.

Roaring crowds thronged the streets as he traveled toward the Capitol building for a meeting with the Chiefs of Staff.
