Short bio of DuBois:

It's probably easier to just rent the movie (assuming you've never seen it) than to try to explain the character, but in a nutshell: Maggie is a suffragette who wants to work as an investigative reporter. She offers to cover the Great Race for a local newspaper, and enters the race herself to "prove" that a woman can do such a thing. She's a bit over the top, feminism-wise. (Jenna has a copy of the movie you can borrow if you wish.)

Other information about your character:

You're a go-getting journalist who wants to be an investigative reporter, but right now you're stuck with the society pages; the editor doesn't think that investigative journalism is a suitable job for a woman.

In an effort to prove yourself, you once pretended to have psychiatric problems in order to become a patient of Dr. Sigmund Fraud, and then wrote a series of articles on him and his methods. This didn't have much effect except to make your boss wonder if you're a little twitchy, and you're still stuck with the society column.

You're covering the Von Blucher fete for the paper (The Daily Globe). The cream of society will be in attendance (including, incidentally, Dr. Fraud).
