### Short bio of Post:

The renowned maven of manners achieved fame in 1922 as her book *Etiquette* topped the non-fiction list for the year.

### Other information about your character:

One of your most prized possessions is the enclosed locket--you wear it always (please wear it to the party). Your grandmother and aunt once lived in the house to which you have been invited, but were arrested during the Civil War on suspicion of complicity with the Rebels. Your aunt died in prison at age 19, awaiting trial. When your mother went to collect her possessions, this was the only thing she had.
